

The Addition of Yam Tuber (Dioscorea alata) Flour As a Source of Prebiotic on Biomilk Synbiotic Characteristics



Abstract. Yam tuber is quite abundant in Indonesia and has high carbohydrate and has inulin content. Tuber yam has not been widely used as ingredient of biomilk synbiotic or yoghurt products. This study was aim to investigate effects addition of yam Tuber (Dioscorea alata) flour as source of prebiotic, on characteristics of biomilk symbiotic. Starter culture used on biomilk making is Streptococcus thermophillus and Lactobacillus bulgaricus as probiotic bacteria used Lactobacillus rhamnosus. The experiment desing in this study using a Completely Randomized Design with six treatments of tree replicates. The treatment on this study was the percentage of yam tuber flour. Different data between subjected will be continued with Least Significant Difference Test (LSD). The results of research showed that addition of yam tuber flour was significant (P<0.05) on pH. total Lactic Acid Bacteria and viscosity of biomilk symbiotic. It was biliference Test (LSD). The results of research showed that addition of yam tuber flour was significant (P<0.05) on pH, total Lactic Acid Bacteria and viscosity of biomilk symbiotic. It was concluded that yam tuber flour could be used as source of prebiotic on biomilk symbiotic. The addition of 1.0 % of yam tuber flour caused highest viability of Lactic acid bacteria, best viscosity and lowest pH and water content of biomilk symbiotic. The addition 1.0 % of yam tuber flour produced the best of biomilk symbiotic characteristics.

Biomilk is fermented drink using cow's milk or UHT milk and Lactic Acid Bacteria (LAB) from Streptococcus thermophillus and Lactobacillus bulgaricus. Biomilk, better known as yogurt, is a fermented milk drink that is very familiar to the community, with a refreshing sour taste. To increase the function of the fermented drink, biomilk needs to be added by probiotics bacteria. Some probiotics bacteria commonly used in fermented drink or biomilk are Lactobacillus acidophilus, Lactobacillus plantarum, Lactobacillus rhamnosus, and Bifidobacterium. Probiotics bacteria of Lactobacillus rhamnosus is a bacteria that is able to decrease cholesterol in advocado fermentation product given to the

Biomilk using probiotics bacteria and adding prebiotics ingredients is called Biomilk synbiotik.

Prebiotics is food ingredient that cannot be digested but it is possible to be used by lactic acid bacteria or probiotic bacteria to increase its viablifia. Some prebiotics commonly used is fructo oligosaccharides (FOSs) like inulin, galakto saccharida (GOSs). Lactitol, lactulose, and inulin are special FOSs. Lactulose, oligofructose and lactitol are compounds that can increase the growth of Bifidobacterium. Fructo oligosaccharide (FOSs) is an important and natural prebiotic. Inulin has the characteristic $\beta(1-2)$ bond





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
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




It is, therefore, the author's responsibility to ensure that the content and layout are correct—no changes can be made after publication.

1. Key requirements


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- the page size should be A4;
- each page should have clear margins of 4cm (top), 2.5cm (left and right) and 2.7cm (bottom);
- pages should not contain page numbers, running heads or footlines;
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The title should be followed by a list of all authors' names and their affiliations. The style for the names is initials (no periods) followed by the family name. The authors' affiliations follow the author list. If there is more than one address then a superscripted number should come at the start of each address; each author should also have a superscripted number or numbers following their name to indicate which address, or addresses, are the appropriate ones for them. E-mail addresses may be given for any or all of the authors.

The abstract follows the list of addresses. The abstract text should be indented 25 mm from the left margin. As the abstract is not part of the text it should be complete in itself; no table numbers, figure numbers, references or displayed mathematical expressions should be included. It should be suitable for direct inclusion in abstracting services.



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

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
